Its multiple sites reflect the organization's internal and external issues, which puts the relevant values for the policy of quality management system and its practices to meet or exceed customer's needs and expectations the satisfaction. Customer satisfaction is supported by continual improvement through planning and objectives of the quality management system and necessary corrective and Preventive actions against nonconformities. The organization shall achieve the management system's effectiveness by reviewing the product. However, monitor and measure the requirements of processes. The organization shall ensure the competence of its quality for the marvellous outcome to quality management system through awareness programmes and shall make the policy statement of quality management system able to be transmissible to its employee and interested parties.
